In 2023, AFNO's "Conversation à la carte" class celebrated 15 years with instructor Laurence Lechat! This course operated on a punch card system, offering flexibility for participants. Mme Lechat prepares weekly discussion topics to French speaking fluency for promote French language learners of the intermediate to advanced levels. We add titles monthly, and feature French reading for all ages, and French educational resources.

In 2023, the AFNO digitized it's catalogue, as well as offered more specific categories for children based on word count. Additionally, a new category was added, "French Language Learners," with resources for adult learners.












FINANCE
